UNICEF donated 70 electronic tablets and accessories necessary for the implementation of the Akelius English program, at the Olivia Espinoza and Emiliano Zapata CASEFs.

Akelius is an application to facilitate the learning of English for children and adolescents, with a game-based methodology through writing, reading, vocabulary and listening.
