Edvin Alijanovic, Minister of Education, Science, Culture and Sports in the Government of the Una-Sana Canton spoke with Rownak Khan, UNICEF Representative in Bosnia and Herzegovina about programs to support the education system implemented by UNICEF with an emphasis on digitalization programs in education and foreign language learning programs in schools.

UNICEF in Bosnia and Herzegovina is committed to a new project to improve Internet access in schools throughout Bosnia and Herzegovina and expects that the USK Government will have support as in previous years when programs of engaging children in the movement in the education process have been successfully implemented.

A new, joint project of UNICEF BiH and the Ministry of Education in BiH aims to better equip primary and secondary schools and provide internet access for children in all schools. USK is already an exceptional example of the success of such projects, according to UNICEF, such as Akelius - a digital foreign language learning platform on which UNICEF BiH, together with partner organizations, started implementing a digital foreign language course and has been successfully incorporated in formal education in several schools in the Una-Sana Canton and Sarajevo Canton.
