This year it is especially important to collect as much as possible during the period 19 September - 31 October, she says. The Akelius foundation has promised to double the amount collected around Sweden during that period. The money will go to projects for children's rights around the world with a focus on the right to education.

The multi-billionaire Roger Akelius is behind the Akelius foundation. He is one of Sweden's richest people after successful property deals. He now lives in the Bahamas and devotes a large part of his life to philanthropic activities.
