AED-Akelius: reintegration ceremony for 50 students in 4 schools in Arafat (PHOTOS)

The NGO Assistance–Education organized, Thursday October 5, 2023, an integration ceremony for 50 children including 27 girls in four basic schools (Touweirjena, Ahmed Zerough, Abba and Bakar) in the Moughataa of Arafat in the wilaya of Nouakchott –South. These are students trained by the NGO AED center on the Akelius foundation system.

Speaking, the coordinator of the Akelius project with AED, Mr. Mohamed Sédinté Tounkara, in his presentation cited some of the objectives of the center: the recovery and reintegration of children who have dropped out of school or are not in school, providing training enabling them to a chance for children from vulnerable groups, to use the most recent educational techniques for better and rapid reintegration through the Akelius approach among others. And, he recalled, from April 2019, the opening date of the center, to October 2023, AED trained and integrated 434 students, including 236 girls.

Mr. Tounkara specified that teachers and management staff benefited from several ANA AQRA training sessions, including three remotely, between 2019 and 2021.
