The creator of Cape East donates 800 million to the children of Gaza

Today the Swedish government has decided to donate 400 million kronor to children in Gaza. Roger Akelius, who "with money from his back pocket" built Cape East in Haparanda for just over 80 million kronor, welcomes the government's announcement.

He doubles the government's contribution and donates 800 million kronor to the children in Gaza via UNICEF.

– I couldn't stand to see a quiet crying child, broken, without food and water, without heat, whose parents had just been buried, he writes in a press release.

Roger Akelius is known for extensive efforts for children in difficulty and is responsible for the largest Swedish donation for humanitarian aid to Ukraine, as he has previously donated 700 million kronor to Ukraine.
