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## **STATE** UNICEF trains teachers in teaching English

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About the use of Akelius Languages, a global platform for language teaching

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In order to promote the implementation of innovative mechanisms that strengthen digital education, English teachers from public schools of the entity received training on the use of Akelius Languages, a global platform for language teaching.

The Ministry of Education and Culture (SEC), in coordination with the office in Mexico of the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), provided guidance to 100 English teachers to learn how to use this innovative application, present in 13 countries.

The teachers participated in the workshop "Facilitating the learning of English of the NNAs in Sonora through the Akelius Languages platform", which will help them implement interactive activities so that students develop their language skills and have a better understanding of the language.

During the meeting, they highlighted the benefits of this tool for its dynamism, which is accessible from a variety of devices, including computers, tablets and smartphones, both online and offline, and is complemented with books, notebooks and games.

The educational and UNICEF authorities highlighted that the implementation of Akelius Languages in Sonora's classrooms has a significant impact since it will provide learning experiences to children and adolescents, which will allow them to transform their future, in addition to favoring the creation of spaces for dialogue and collective learning for teachers and managers.
